

What Is an Endodontist?

Endodontists are dentists with special training in endodontic procedures or "root canals". To become specialists, they complete an additional two or more years of advanced training in endodontics after dental school. They perform routine as well as difficult and very complex procedures, including endodontic surgery. Endodontists are also experienced at finding the cause of oral and facial pain that has been difficult to diagnose.

Why would I need Endodontic Treatment?

Endodontic treatment is necessary when the pulp becomes inflamed or infected. The most common reasons for inflammation or infection are deep cavities, repeated dental procedures, cracks or chips. If pulp inflammation or infection is left untreated, it can cause pain or lead to an abscess. After successful endodontic treatment, the tooth continues to perform.
